1- Do I have to watch the film before we meet?

No. We will give a summary and then show clips during the discussion. However, it may be easier to follow if you have seen the entire film.

2- Are the films available from the church?

While we have copies of some of the films, we do not have them for every film. However, all but one are available on streaming platforms and at the local library. You will want to put a hold on a copy for it to come in on time.

3- Will there be a time to watch the film at the church if I don't want to stream it or check it out from the library?

Yes. We will be at the church every Sunday at 3:00PM starting on July 23rd to watch that week's movie. With a few movies, we have extra copies and will let you know at the previous meeting if you want to get one.

4- This starts at 5:30. Will there be dinner available?

Yes. We will provide a small meal with popcorn for each night we meet. While it's not necessary, it will be helpful if you let the office know you are coming by Wednesday afternoon.

5- Are the films family-friendly?

Yes. There are two films rated PG-13 and the rest are PG.

6- Will there be childcare available?

If you contact us the Monday before the session you wish to attend, we can arrange for childcare.
